
## PRE-RIDING INSPECTION

At the start of each riding day, perform a general inspection to be certain the motorcycle is in good, safe operating condition.

Gasoline Level - Check gasoline level and fill tank if low.



Capacity: 2l (0.53 U.S. gal., 0.44 Imp. gal.)

\* Use low-lead or regular gasoline with a Research Octane number of 91 or higher, or a Pump Octane number of 86 or higher.

For Australia and New Zealand models; Use unleaded gasoline only.

The use of leaded gasoline will cause spark plug fouling.

\* When refueling take care to exclude dirt, water, or other contaminants from the fuel tank.

## CAUTION

Do not pre-mix gasoline and oil.
Fill the fuel tank with gasoline only.

## WARNING

- \* Gasoline is extremely flammable and is explosive under certain conditions. Refuel in a well ventilated area with engine stopped. Do not smoke or allow open flames or sparks in the area where the motorcycle is refueled or where gasoline is stored.
- \* Do not overfill the tank (there should be no fuel in the filler neck). After refueling, make sure the filler cap is closed securely.
- Gasoline is harmful or fatal is swallowed. Avoid repeated or prolonged contact with skin or breathing of vapor. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. If gasoline is swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.
