SAFE RIDING SUGGESTIONS

- Always make a PRE-RIDING INSPEC-TION prior to riding your motorcycle (see page 12).
- Never ride a motorcycle unless you are wearing a helmet and it is recommended that the motorcyclist wear boots, gloves, eye protection, and bright clothing to further improve rider safety.
- 3. Luggage racks or optional baskets are primarily for light weight items. Distribute the weight of cargo equally on both sides if baskets are attached to the rear rack. Make sure cargo is secure and will not shift while riding. Refer to page 38 for additional information on loading.
- Place both hands on the handlebars and both feet on the foot pegs while riding.

- It is recommended that you become familiar with your new HONDA NC50 by riding in an uncongested area before riding on the public roadways.
- Be sure to signal when making a turn or changing lanes.
- Do not ride on the roadway shoulder. Remember a motorcyclist should always preserve nature and respect property.
