CLEANING

Clean your motorcycle regularly to protect the surface finishes and inspect it for damage, wear and oil seepage.

CAUTION:

- * Avoid spraying high pressure water (typical in coin-operated car washes) at the following areas:
 Wheel Hubs
 Muffler Outlet
 Under Seat
- Ignition Switch
 Handlebar Switches

 1. After cleaning, rinse the motorcycle thoroughly with plenty of clean water. Strong

detergent residue can corrode alloy parts.

- 2. Dry the motorcycle thoroughly.
- Start the engine and let it run for several minutes.

 Test the brakes before riding the motorcycle in traffic. Several applications may be necessary to restore normal braking performance.

AWARNING

* Braking performance may be impaired immediately after washing the motorcycle.
