Engine Stop Switch

The engine stop switch (Fig. 2-6) is next to the left handgrip, and it has three positions. When the switch is in the Ω (RUN) position, the engine will operate. When the switch is in either \bowtie (OFF) position, the engine will not operate.

This switch is intended primarily as a safety or emergency control, and it should normally remain in the Ω (RUN) position.

NOTE:

If you stop your FOURTRAX by turning the engine stop switch \boxtimes (OFF), be sure to turn the ignition switch \bigcirc (OFF) to prevent battery discharge.


