

Is Your ATV Ready to Ride?

Fuel Check the level and add fuel (page 90) if

needed. Also make sure the fuel fill cap is

securely fastened. Check for leaks.

Tyres Use a gauge to check the air pressure. Adjust if

needed. Also look for signs of damage or

excessive wear (page 134).

Drive Chain Check the condition and slack. Adjust and

> lubricate if needed. Also check the chain slider for wear and replace if needed (page 143).

Drivetrain Boots Check for damage (page 142).

Guards Check for damage or looseness (page 140).

Nuts & Bolts Check the wheels to see that the axle nuts are

> tightened. Use a wrench to make sure all accessible nuts, bolts, and fasteners are tight.

Underbody & Check for, and remove, any dirt, vegetation or Exhaust System

other debris that could be a fire hazard or interfere with the proper operation of the

vehicle.
